### AFTER SCHOOL VIRTUAL ACT TEST PREP CLASS: STARTING SATURDAY, JANUARY 28

Cambridge Educational Services is offering an after school, virtual ACT test prep class to Northview students starting Saturday, January 28, 2023 and ending on March 4, 2023. This will align with the March 7 ACT administration at NHS for all 11<sup>th</sup> grade students and prepare all others for the April ACT date.

**Who can take it:** Recommended for 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders, but 9<sup>th</sup> graders are allowed.

**Cost:** \$25

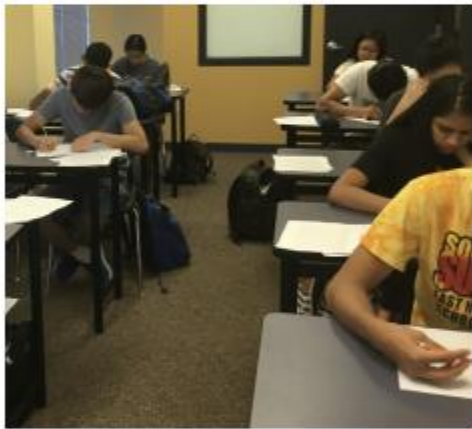
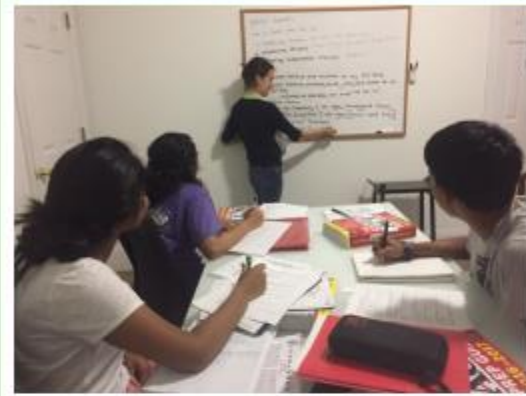
