COURSE REGISTRATION FOR NEXT YEAR

This important announcement will be published once a week until April.

Our registration process for the 2023-2024 school year began on January 23rd. Students will have from January 23rd through the end of May to choose classes for the next school year. This is the only time students will be able to participate in the scheduling of classes, so please make it a top priority. Please discuss course selections with current teachers and your parents.

We understand there are many factors to consider when making decisions regarding course selection and electives. Northview has several resources available to you to address your registration questions. We ask that you review the resources below and participate as needed to ensure your registration questions are answered in a timely manner.

Registration Timeline

Early January

- Teachers will have conversations with students regarding course recommendations for the next school year as they are the subject matter experts and can best advise students about class placement. **Please speak with your student about the recommendations their teachers have made.**
- Students should familiarize themselves with Georgia High School [Graduation Requirements](#)
- Students should read to learn about the NHS course offerings and prerequisites in order to be prepared for course registration.

February

- February 6th – 10th - Students will see their course selections in Infinite Campus and will choose their electives
- February 10th – Deadline for all application-based courses (Yearbook, Lit Mag, Mentorship, etc)
- February 14th, 15th, and 16th – Counselors meet with all Rising 10th, 11th, and 12th graders to review their course plans
- February 22nd – Second course verification visible in Infinite Campus – all courses listed academic and electives

March

- Parents and students will be able to view their final course requests for the 2023-2024 school year
- PLEASE NOTE: this is not your student's schedule but just their requests; schedules are built over the summer and will be released towards the beginning of August.

April

- April 10th – 14th – Course Waiver Forms available to students. Students may ONLY waiver into 2 courses MAXIMUM. If more than 2 waivers are received NO waivers will be processed.

May

- May 12th – ALL online request forms must be submitted. Students must submit & register for all online course requests (FALL & SPRING) by May 12th. LATE submissions will NOT be approved.
- May 26th – Final date to request and update course requests for 23-24 school year
