Dear Parents of 2024 Graduates,

It has been a couple months since our last *Senior Newsletter*, and we have a lot of new information to share. Please take a moment to read this thoroughly. New information is highlighted in yellow.

Graduation Ceremony

WHEN: May 22, 2:00PM
Graduates must transport themselves to the event and arrive by 12:30 pm
Doors to the Amphitheatre for parent and guest seating will open at 1:15pm.
ALL guests should be seated by 1:50pm so we ask that you plan to arrive 20 minutes early.

WHERE: Ameris Bank Amphitheatre, Alpharetta, GA
(Please note the addresses below for the various parking lots.)
Lawn seating will be closed for all graduation ceremonies.

PRACTICE: Monday, May 13, 5:30pm at Ameris Bank Amphitheatre.
Practice is mandatory. Students may not participate in the ceremony if absent from practice.
All seniors will be excused from class to attend graduation practice.

TICKETS: Graduates will be allotted ten FREE tickets. Once the tickets are distributed, we are not able to replace them if they are lost. This year we will have extra tickets available. If more tickets are needed, contact the Northview front office to request additional tickets, 470-254-3828 (extension 0).

GRADUATION FUNDRAISER

The Graduation Committee is auctioning off first row seat to the highest bidder. These seats will be in addition to the 10 ticketed seats each student will receive at practice. For full details, please see the attached flyer.

ATTIRE FOR GRADUATION CEREMONY

For Girls: Dress or pant suit, with dress shoes or sandals
NO jeans, shorts, flip flops, athletic shoes, or stiletto heels
For Boys: Dress shirt with tie, dress slacks, dark dress shoes with dark socks
NO jeans, shorts, sleeveless shirts, flip flops, sandals, or athletic shoes

When crossing the stage graduates are to have their gowns fully zipped and mortarboard (cap) on. Mortarboard (caps) may not be decorated or have any writing on it.

Graduation Packet/Graduation Program

At practice, each student will receive a packet which includes:

- Two (2) commemorative, full-length graduation programs. At the gate, guests will receive a shortened program with a QR code that will enable access to the electronic full-length program.
- Honor cords, if awarded by Northview Honor Societies
- Silver Envelope with letters of congratulations from family and friends
- Ten Tickets to distribute to family and friends. All guests must have a ticket to enter the ceremony.

Handicapped Parking: Drop off guests needing assistance at the EAST Gate. You may park in Lot C if you have a state-issued handicap parking permit. Up to two guests may sit with the guest needing ADA seating. Please be advised that even the handicapped parking is a good distance from the seats inside the venue. If guests have mobility issues, consider renting a wheelchair or have them view the ceremony from the live stream link in the comfort of their home.

Important Reminders from the Counseling Department

SENIOR EXIT SURVEY, PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE, & PROOF OF SCHOLARSHIPS (Due by May 1st)

Every year, the State of Georgia requires that graduating seniors complete a Senior Exit Survey. This task has been assigned to all graduating students in Naviance. If applicable, students will also need to complete the following forms:

NHS Microsoft Forms, if applicable

- College Acceptance Form, if applicable: <https://forms.office.com/r/th6iZmYOLx> (assists in ensuring admission data in Naviance remains accurate for future years)
- Scholarship Acceptance Form, if applicable: <https://forms.office.com/r/YY9zdDamAy> (total number reported to the county)

FINAL TRANSCRIPT

If you will be attending college after high school, you must request your final transcript once available. You may only request **one final transcript**, as your final transcript is the one that gets sent in June after your senior year grades are finalized. Colleges require a final transcript as part of attendance at their school. Students will request the final transcript through Common App. If they applied through another platform, they will request the transcript through Scrib Order. If requesting through Scrib Order, please “Final Transcript” under “Special Instructions”.

FAFSA

FCS Laptop/Device Collection:

Device collection for Seniors will be on May 7th in the media center. A damaged device fine is \$100, a lost device fine is \$250, and a lost charger fine is \$30. Failure to return your device or pay fines will result in the withholding of your graduation packet and may result in the withholding of your diploma.

Senior Check-Out Form

Senior Check-Out Forms will be available on April 29th in the Attendance Office. Prior to your graduate’s last day of school, they will need to complete this form which will ensure they have returned all devices, textbooks, sports uniforms, music performance uniforms, music instruments, library books and have paid any outstanding fees. The completion of this form is mandatory to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Junior Senior Prom

This year’s prom is scheduled for Saturday, May 11, 7:30pm-11:00pm at The Fox Theater in the Egyptian Ballroom.

- Tickets will be \$100 each, however SENIORS will have the opportunity to purchase one ticket on May 1st for \$80. After that, tickets will be sold at the regular price to all 11th and 12th grades until May 10th when ticket sales close. Tickets may be purchased online (OSP) from www.northviewhigh.com.
- Forms to request a non-Northview guest are in room 508. Juniors and Seniors may invite one guest. **These forms are due by Friday, May 10th at 8:20 am.**
- There is a show at the Fox Theater the same night as our prom. Plan to arrive early to accommodate for parking.
- Appetizers, desserts, and drinks will be served.
- The Prom King and Queen will be announced about 9:30pm.
- Parking at The Fox Theater is not included in the price of the ticket.

PROM CHARTER BUS

This year, Northview is offering a charter bus to and from The Fox Theater for prom. The bus will leave Northview at 7:00pm on Saturday, May 11 and pick up students from The Fox at 10:45pm for their return to Northview. The cost is \$50/person for the roundtrip. Seating is limited and must be reserved and paid for from OSP.

Northview Senior Class Field Trips

The seniors have one more planned field trip during the school day on April 24th to Stone Mountain Park. The cost for the field trips is \$50 which includes transportation and lunch. Shortly before the trip, a consent form will be sent home for parents to sign. Seniors will receive more information on the field trip after Spring Break via the daily Titan Announcements and in their Literature classes.

Graduation Walks

Our feeder elementary schools host *Graduation Walks* at their schools, so graduates can revisit the place their formal education started. Bring your cap & gown to this event and wear a t-shirt indicating your plan for next school year.

SENIOR SILVER ENVELOPES

It is a Northview tradition for the PTO to sponsor the request and collection of congratulatory notes for seniors then package them up in "Senior Silver Envelopes." To make this program successful, parents need to ask family, friends, teachers, coaches, or any person that has a relationship with the graduate to write messages to celebrate this important milestone. The notes and cards are mailed to the school, then collected by a designee from the PTO to compile them for distribution in the graduate's packet which they get at graduation practice.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- The Senior Silver Envelope is a silver Northview embossed 9" x 12" envelope.
- The largest item to send is 8 ½" x 11" flat card or note, it must be FLAT.
- Where to send and how to address it?
 - 1st line: Student's Name
 - 2nd line: Northview High School PTO Silver Envelope
 - 3rd line: 10625 Parsons Road
 - 4th line: Johns Creek, GA 30097

Please make sure your family and friends know how to address the cards for mailing. Stress to everyone you reach out to: DO NOT SEND CASH, CHECKS, OR GIFT CARDS. This program is meant for words of well wishes only.

- Deadline: All cards/notes must be received by Friday, May 3, 2024.
 - Cards may be dropped off at school, but they must be in an envelope addressed correctly.

This unique tradition means a lot to the graduate. Kind words and inspirational messages sent from people who have touched their lives during their first eighteen years of life will be long remembered.

Here is a sample email you may copy and send to your family and friends asking them to participate in this program:

We are writing to let you know that. will be graduating from Northview High School on May 22nd, 2024. As someone who has been dear to his/her heart over the years, we would like to ask you for a favor. If you choose to participate, please mail your card or letter to the school. **The deadline to receive cards is May 7, 2024.**
