Information Item: New Math Curriculum Implementation Report (Heatherington & Jeelani)

- New Math curriculum focuses more on reasoning and problem solving skills instead of just rote memory alone.
- A few units have been moved between Math subjects. Teachers are working to find holes in student learning due to this transition.
- New Math books from FCS will not be ready until January. Teachers can use the SAAVAS platform in the meantime.
- May 2023 Milestones grades for Algebra 1 were very good for AHS. AHS had a +8.7% increase in students at developing/proficient/distinguished and a +21.6% increase in students at proficient/distinguished
- Algebra 1 PLC strategies that likely helped raise the scores:
 - 2 RISE sessions per week
 - Bootcamp 1 day (4 hours) 2 weeks before the EOC
 - Anchor time RTI
 - Delta Math available over school breaks
 - NHS tutors available
