### **Digital PSAT 2023**

1. Today, your 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> graders will be participating in the Digital Readiness Check/Stress Test. This must be completed on an FCS device and that device must have the Bluebook app. Students should go to the media center first thing this morning if they do not have a device. Personal devices are not permitted. During the stress test today, students will get their log-in credentials for the Bluebook app. I strongly recommend that they take a picture of this and have it easily accessible. With this information, they can log-in to the Bluebook app and take a full length practice test and go through the test preview – all resources to help your child be as prepared as possible for the PSAT.
2. Next week, 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> graders will take the PSAT. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will take the PSAT on Thursday, October 12<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will take the PSAT on Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup>. As students arrive to school, they should make their way to the testing location. Reporting time is 8:10am. Students should monitor their FCS email for an email advising their testing date, room number, and proctor. We understand that it is a short week for students, but it is imperative that students report for the PSAT on their assigned day.
3. As a reminder, please note that AHS will be on an altered bell schedule during both testing days once testing is concluded. Students should report as directed in their schedule. Absences must follow normal attendance policies. Please check the AHS website for the bell schedule and other important information.
