### Information Item: No Place for Hate Conference Recap (Jankovic & Park)

- 7 students with diverse backgrounds were selected to attend.
- The focus was on learning what biases we have and how to work together.
- Consensus from students was that this program is not needed at AHS. We do not seem to have the same issues as other schools represented at the conference.
- SGC conversation that it was a good experience and good research but not a good fit for AHS

### Information Item: Principal update (Scheifflee)

- Course Selection:
  - Middle school to high school transition events are in process
  - Round 1 of course selection ends February 16
  - AHS has had more social media presence during the course selection process.
  - QR code is available for parents/students to submit questions. 60 questions have been submitted so far. All answered within 48 hours.
- Practice Field work in progress

- VAF for Night School approved by the district cabinet. Now moves to the Board.
  - Clarification that this is not for credit recovery but an opportunity for students who are credit deficient due to circumstances such as moving
  - Night school will utilize district approved Canvas courses
- Discipline:
  - ISS lacks structure and accountability.
    - Mr. Dice is creating structured lessons focused on the Code of Conduct. Students in ISS will receive these lessons instead of just working on course work.
    - So far students who participated in the ISS lessons have not been in ISS again.
- Mr. Dice is working with a cohort of struggling 9<sup>th</sup> graders who are failing 4 or more classes. They work with Chase Mayes on study skills, test prep, and mentorship
- 1 counselor leaving tomorrow. New counselor starting later this week. There will only be a 3 day gap. This position is SGC funded so no contract is guaranteed year to year.

Information Item: Election Update (Brandau)

- 2 seats available—2 parent, 1 staff.
- After 1 week open, 3 parents and 2 teachers have declared for the election
- Elections April 17-24.
- Committee will meet after Spring Break to plan election promotion.
