


SAFARI Montage Student Guide

SAFARI Montage is a digital repository of instructional videos that all students can access. Teachers may provide a direct link to a video students can access or students may be asked to login and search for a video or other resource.

Students can access SAFARI Montage on a variety of devices. For more information about technical specifications, please visit: <https://tinyurl.com/fcsdigitalresourcetechsps>

If students click on a link to a SAFARI Montage resource, they will be brought to the SAFARI Montage login screen.

Students should enter their Fulton student ID# in the username box and their Fulton password. Elementary students' password is their birthday in this format: MMDDYY
MS/HS students were encouraged to change their password.



If teachers ask students to login to SAFARI Montage from Launchpad, students should:

1. On a computer go to <https://launchpad.classlink.com/fcs>
On a mobile device download the **ClassLink** app from the store. The first time you launch the app it will ask you for the name of the school district. Type **Fulton**.
2. In the username box enter student ID#. Elementary students' password is their birthday in this format: MMDDYY
MS/HS students were encouraged to change their password. Their Launchpad password is the same password they use to login to a computer.
3. Once logged into Launchpad, click the SAFARI Montage icon.
